



The *Wireless Wilderness* Cell Phone Tour at West 11th Street Park

The *Wireless Wilderness* Cell Phone Tour is a self-guided nature tour that can be accessed by cell phone or by smart phone. Each tour stop is marked by a sign. Just follow the directions on the signs to take the tour:

- Call 713-401-2441 from your cell phone and press the stop number, **or**
- Go to www.myoncell.mobi/7134012441 on your smart phone.

Once you are on the tour, you can access other commands by pressing these keys:

- Press **1** to fast forward.
- Press **2** to pause/play.
- Press **3** to rewind.
- Press **#** to stop.
- Press ***0** to leave feedback.
